Coastal Carolinas Association of REALTORS® Urges Flood Victims to Apply for Assistance

MYRTLE BEACH, November 3, 2015 - The Coastal Carolinas Association of REALTORS® (C.C.A.R.), urges victims of October's catastrophic flooding to apply for a grant from The REALTORS® Relief Foundation, established by The National Association of REALTORS®, which provides mortgage or rent relief up to \$1,000 to those who qualify.

As of today, South Carolina REALTORS®, The Coastal Carolinas Association of REALTORS® and other REALTOR® associations in South Carolina and across the country have raised a collective total of \$469,035 for the foundation, reserved exclusively to help South Carolina flood victims. Only a small portion of that total has been distributed to approved applicants, there is a remaining \$439,000 to distribute.

"Though the flooding has receded, repairs remain. We urge all homeowners who incurred any damage, regardless of extent, to apply for assistance. There is money just waiting to be distributed. By spreading the word to family, friends and neighbors we can help deliver much needed assistance." said Laura Crowther, CEO for the Coastal Carolinas Association of REALTORS®.

To be eligible, you must be a South Carolina resident who suffered property damage to your primary residence. Assistance is limited to \$1,000 per applicant and one grant per residence.
